

## **EDINBURGH PATTERNS**

Edinburgh had a huge number of patterns, especially for tumblers. The firm supplied items for promotions, especially those related to whisky, and to hotels and stores.

Edinburgh has for many years imported glass in addition to the items made in Scotland. These were sold under the 'Edinburgh International' label and were cheaper, but still of reasonable quality and style.

Over time there have been some changes in patterns and styles. The engraving on the earlier 'Thistle' was hand engraved with varying skill. Recent items were engraved by machine and are very uniform. Some styles were given longer stems or changed bowl shape following fashion. Occasionally a name was used again on a totally different style.
